



Certificate III in Children's Services CHC30402

The Certificate III in Children's Services is part of a suite of courses which provide a comprehensive package of training to meet the needs of the children's services industry. Students will be equipped with the skills and expertise for a challenging career with young children aged from 0-12 years.

You will learn about providing food and physical care; responding to illnesses and accidents; and how to foster and support the emotional well being of infants while overseeing their physical, social and psychological development. You will also be able to provide appropriate administration support in a child-care facility, while also providing a safe and healthy working environment.

Entry Requirements: Minimum entry age requirement is 16 years

Job opportunities

Assistant in child care centre, family day care, kindergarten, preschool and outside of school hours care

Features

- *Bracken Ridge, Caboolture campus and vocational placement locations:* One day per week, 9am to 4pm, includes alternate weeks in TAFE studies and vocational placement
- Commitment to full program required
- Students will need to have a Positive Notice Blue Card for child related employment issued by the Commission for Children & Young People & Child Guardian to undertake the vocational placement component as a TAFE student. Schools and students are encouraged to source suitable vocational placement centres
- **\$50 materials fee** per semester (total \$200) for program
