To achieve their qualification students may be required to attend extra workshops or online sessions in addition to their programmed classes. All units listed must be completed successfully to gain a Certificate III.

Students completing the Certificate III gain full credit towards a Diploma of Hospitality, and guaranteed entry into the Diploma Program at BNIT on completion of their Certificate III studies.

It is a requirement of this certificate that 36 services are performed in a hospitality enterprise to achieve qualification.
