

# Hairdressing

## Course in Hairdressing

This course is the first step to a career in the hairdressing and beauty industry or in associated retail areas, where quality training is provided for those wishing to pursue a hairdressing/beauty career.

It is an introductory course with limited practical work, however the vocational placement and on campus salons provide students with training in a simulated environment. Students will receive basic training in health and hygiene, communication, coordinating salon tasks, retail, greeting clients and shampooing skills.

### Job opportunities

*Apprentice hairdresser, tea and tidy and salon assistant.*

### Features

- *Caboolture campus:* One day per week, 7 hour session x 1 semester, 9am to 4pm
- Work placement required separate to class times
- Articulate with credit for units completed into Certificate III in Hairdressing Apprenticeship
- Course is an introduction to the hairdressing industry and includes selected units from the Certificate III in Hairdressing. Students will be awarded a Statement of Attainment for units of competency achieved
