

Certificate III in Interior Decoration (Retail Services) LMF31908

During this program you will gain knowledge and skills in practical colour mixing and applying colour schemes for different rooms within a house, as well as a retail setting, such as a hair salon or café.

You will also learn how to use an interior decoration computer software package that enables the building of a house, adding relevant furniture, flooring, paint and decorative accessories.

The two dimensional component of the program teaches students how to create a presentation sample board ready to present to a client. These boards have a combination of fabrics, flooring, images from magazines and many other samples applied to show the decorator's ideas.

Drawing is one of the most important parts of decorating and a series of techniques and relevant media are taught within this program.

Delivery: This program is delivered face-to-face, one day per week from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm.

Dress code: It is a workplace health and safety requirement to wear fully enclosed shoes.

Campus location: Ithaca.

Duration: 18 months (3 semesters).

Fees: \$120 per semester, \$360 full program, plus \$37 administration fee per year.
